IN AN EMERGENCY WHEN YOU HEAR IT. DO IT.

LOCKDOWN! LOCKS, LIGHTS, OUT OF SIGHT.

STUDENTS

Move away from sight Maintain silence Do not open the door

TEACHER

Lock interior doors Turn out the lights Move away from sight Do not open the door Maintain silence Take attendance



LOCKOUT! SECURE THE PERIMETER.

STUDENTS

TEACHER

Return inside Business as usual Bring everyone indoors Lock perimeter doors

Increase situational awareness

Business as usual Take attendance



EVACUATE! TO ANNOUNCED LOCATION.

STUDENTS

Bring your phone

Leave your stuff behind

Follow instructions

TEACHER

Lead evacuation to location

Take attendance

Notify if missing, extra or injured

students



SHELTER! HAZARD AND SAFETY STRATEGY.

STUDENTS

TEACHER

Hazard Safety Strategy Evacuate to shelter area Take attendance Tornado

Hazmat Seal the room Earthquake Drop, cover and hold Tsunami Get to high ground

Lead safety strategy





General Security

- RELATIONSHIPS!
- Employee vigilance
- All exterior doors are locked during student day
- ► Front entrance is monitored. (Visitors may be "challenged.")
- Classroom door-handles locked
- Visitors report to office
- SROs Middle Schools & High Schools
- Communication Outside

- R.E.C.E.S.S. Radios
 - Rapid Emergency Communications for Every Sarpy School
 - District-Wide Communication
 - ▶ 911 Communication
 - Emergency Button
- ParentLink
 - Phone
 - Email
 - Texts

Training

- Reviewed with Principals annually
- Principals train building teachers
- Other employee groups: Custodians, Building & Grounds, Subs, Student Teachers, Paras, etc.

Drills/Practice - Schools

- Lockdown 1 per semester
- Lockout 1 per semester
- Fire 1 per month (law)
- Tornado 1 per semester (law)
- ► Bus 1 per semester (Rule)
- Radio Approximately every other month
- Evacuation & Relocation

Drills/Practice - District

- Mock Exercises
- County-wide events
- Table-top scenarios
